WARM-UP QUESTION:

What's the strangest "short cut" or "rabbit trail" you've heard of or taken on a road trip?

"Torn Relationships" (Acts 15:36-41)

Despite an ugly split, God was still able to use Paul and Barnabas. What are other examples of good things that still happened despite arguments or break ups?

"Taking Timothy" (Acts 16:1-5)

Timothy was circumcised to better connect with Jews as a missionary. What are things Christians might do today to better connect with other groups?

"Go West Young Man" (Acts 16:6-10)

Paul's destinations changes a few times despite trying to follow Gods direction. What are the causes of changes in your life's path? How do you see God involved in those changes of directions?

REFLECTION QUESTION:

God directs our path despite disagreements, our parentage and background, obstacles, and our wrong choices. The key in growing through this is our "daily intimate relationship" with God. How constant and close is your relationship with Him lately?
