ACTS 17: 22-34

WARM-UP QUESTION:

What comes to mind when you hear the word "Greek"?

"5 Steps of Effective Witnessing" (Acts 17: 22-31)

Paul comments on the religious culture and the altar to an unknown god to make a connection with Greek unbelievers. What are commonalities that can be used to make a connection with people in our culture today?

Paul mixes quotes from Greek writers with Jewish scripture to be relevant to his audience in Athens. What are ways you've seen Christians be relevant to people today that lead to conversations about Jesus?

"3 Responses" (Acts 17: 32-34)

One of the responses by the Greeks in Athens is to delay and wait to hear more. How do you handle someone delaying talking about Jesus with you? (Or Are you delaying talking to someone about Jesus?)

REFLECTION QUESTION:

Pastor Brian encourages that Paul's example shows we need to know God and know people and have the compassionate courage to share the gospel. Are you praying for that compassionate courage to share?
