

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS | ACTS 18: 18-28 | OCTOBER 17-18

### “Discipleship”

#### *Warm Up Question*

Imagine you are going on a business trip and can take up to 2 people. What type(s) of people would you want to bring along, or what kinds of skills would you want your travel partners to have?

### **Barbershop Stop (v. 18)**

Paul gets a haircut as part of a fulfillment of a vow he made to the Lord. What are vows Christians make today? What are good ways to mark or celebrate them?

### **Paul Modeled Discipleship in Corinth (v. 1-23)**

Paul spent lots of time teaching and modeling to Aquila and Priscilla and even asked them to journey with him to other places. What is a good way to start a discipleship relationship with someone?

### **Aquila and Priscilla Model Discipleship in Ephesus (v. 24-26)**

Aquila and Priscilla help Apollos move on to Achaia after being disciplined by them. What are good ways to let go or to release someone from a discipleship relationship?

#### *Reflection Question*

Looking at Paul’s model in Acts 18, Pastor Brian points out three steps or phases of discipling someone:

- Get Close- intentionally connecting and being real.
- Coach- discussing and modeling God’s Truth.
- Multiply- letting them go to pass on God’s Truth to others.

Have you been through those phases with someone? Are you in any of these phases now with someone?
